Research different type of aeroplanes – can you junk model your favourite aeroplane using materials you might find at home – you could always paint it too!! 😊

### Science – Forces

Which material does a car travel the furthest on? Carry out a test to see which material needs the most and least force when you push a car along it. You could measure how far your car travels.

Research your favourite aeroplane and make a factfile all about it!

### Spelling/Phonics

Every Friday you will receive spellings to be learnt for a test on the following Monday. These spellings will be in line with the sounds learnt during our phonics lessons.

Can you write a poem all about a tree – you can perform this to your friends!

Make space themed cakes and write a set of instructions to show how to make them.

### Writing Task

Write a description about the superhero provided. Remember to use adjectives to describe and don't forget capital letters and full stops.

Research Tim Peak. Make a fact file all about his life. What has he achieved? Why is he significant?

Make your very own pizza, cake or cookie and show the different fractions **whole, half and quarters.**
