Reading

You must read at least 3 times a week at home. Each time ask an adult to write a comment on Go Read! Remember to bring your books into school everyday.

Maths Task

Complete the addition and subtraction activities.

Can you complete the missing number challenges?

Science

Choose either a frog, butterfly, chicken or sunflower and create a poster to show it's life cycle. Write some sentences to explain what happens in each stage.

Reading Task

Read the text about Pirates and answer the questions about the text.

Draw/paint a picture of your favourite memory from Year 2. Write a sentence next to it explaining what the memory is and why it's your favourite.

Times Tables

Challenge yourself to learn a times table that you are not confident with – start with either 2, 3, 5 or 10's.

Science

Keep a food diary for the week. What do you eat for breakfast, lunch and dinner? What have you chosen from each of the different food groups?

Spelling/Phonics

Every Friday you will receive spellings to be learnt for a test on the following Friday. These spellings will be in line with the spelling rule we will be learning each week.

History

Research Matthew Flinders and why he was an important person. Create a factfile explaining why we remember Matthew in our history and why he was important in Lincolnshire.

Transition Task

Create a poster about yourself for your new teacher. What do you want them to know about you?

Complete by: 25.06.25

Science Task

Think about how you can keep healthy? What would you need to eat? Create a healthy meal you could eat by drawing pictures – maybe you could make this meal at home?

Design and create models to show the lifecycle of a frog. You could use modelling clay, paint or collage materials.

Complete by: 2.07.25

Writing Task

It's nearly the end of our Year 2 journey! Write a letter to Dr Early to convince him to let us have a party at the end of the term.

Science

Create a poster to show how to look after our bodies. This might be a healthy eating poster, a poster showing how to brush your teeth or a poster showing how to wash your hands.

Number Facts

Practice your multiplication and division facts for the 3 X tables (up to 12 X 3).
e.g. $3 \times 2 = 6$
 $2 \times 3 = 6$
 $6 \div 2 = 3$
 $6 \div 3 = 2$
