### Challenge:

Can you do some writing in an unusual place? In the garden, at the park, in the wardrobe? Take a picture and upload it to Tapestry or print it off and stick in your homework book.

### Maths Task

Gather a collection of 5 items. Ask someone to hide some of the items in a bucket or box. Can you work out how many objects they have hidden?  
Complete by: 21/01/26

### Challenge:

Can you hide some socks around the house and find the matching one to make a pair?

### Challenge:

Design a poster to stick on a police station or hospital window thanking the people who have helped you or other people.

### Challenge:

Can you do something to help someone at home? You could dry up, lay the table, make your bed, tidy the shoes away neatly.

### Phonics

Please practice spelling these see it, say it words in your spelling journal.

### Challenge:

Can you role play being a vet and caring for an animal. You could use a teddy or a real pet if you have one.

### Challenge:

Can you set a goal or challenge for yourself that you would like to achieve by the end of term? For example, to be able to form numbers 1-10 correctly.

### Understanding of the World Task:

Draw a wintery picture in your homework book and label with simple words e.g cold, wet,
