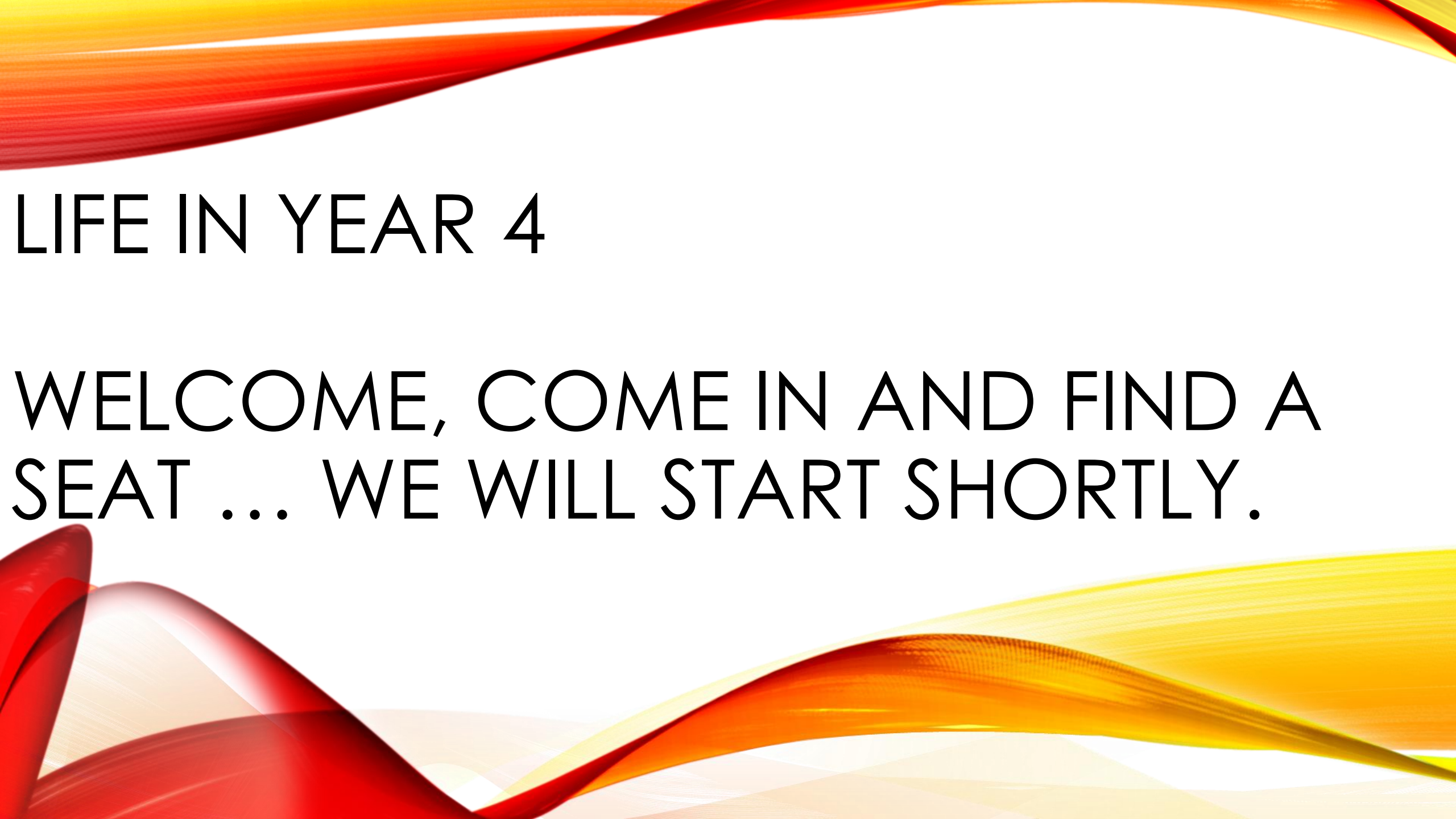

READING BOOKS

The children have been allocated two books.

One of the books is 'banded' and follows the reading scheme in school. This will also help them to access a range of texts throughout the year.

The other book is their reading for pleasure book and is chosen by the child themselves.

The children are read with at least once a week by myself or Miss Wenninger.

All reading needs to be logged on Boom Reader at least 3 times a week. (formally Go Read).

PE AND SWIMMING

PE

PE is on a Tuesday afternoon.

It is an expectation that all children have their PE kits in school at all times (in case it changes). Ear rings must be removed and cannot be taped over (staff can also not remove them).

Swimming:

The children will go Swimming and will require swimming kit (towel costume/shorts and a swimming hat).

NON PARTICIPATION

PE

Any children who are unable to take part in PE will go out and listen to the input/skills part and then will be sent back inside to complete a task/intervention.



TIMES TABLES



- Children should be practising their times tables 3x a week as part of their weekly Pick 'n' mix homework to support their progression in maths
- Children need to know the multiplication and the division facts
- By the end of Year 4, all children are expected to know all of the times tables and division facts to 12 x 12
- Children need to be fluent in the times tables, including the division facts, in order to achieve a certificate
- Times table fluency is vital to ensure children can access all areas of the Maths curriculum
- The Y4 children will sit the Maths Times Table check in June – this will test their times table knowledge and speed (very similar to Rock slams on TT Rockstars).
- TT Rockstar competitions will take place throughout the year (dates TBC)



TIMES TABLE CERTIFICATES

CRITERIA:

Certificate:	Criteria:
Pink	I can count in 10's up to 100. I can double, halve and share numbers to 20.
Red	I can count in 2', 5's and 10's forwards, backwards and starting from different numbers.
Blue	I can recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.
Green	I can recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.
Purple	I can recall and use multiplication and division facts for times tables up to 12 X 12.
Silver	I can multiply and divide whole numbers and decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.
Gold	I can calculate multiplication facts for 2-digit numbers X 1-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers X 1-digit numbers.

YEAR GROUP EXPECTATIONS

Year 1:

By the end of Year 1, all children should be able to count in 2s, 5s and 10s (forwards, backwards and random).

Year 2:

By the end of Year 2, all children should know their 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables

Year 3:

By the end of Year 3, all children should know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 times tables

Year 4:

By the end of Year 4, all children should know all times tables up to 12 x 12

Year 5:

Consolidating and embedding in other areas of the curriculum (silver/gold certificate)

Year 6:

Consolidating and embedding in other areas of the curriculum (silver/gold certificate)
