Reading

Reading Task

Read the facts on castles and answer the questions in your book. (Sheet provided)

Create your own story book at home and bring to school to add to our reading area for your friends to enjoy reading.

Make an information book about castles. Include drawings and diagrams. What fascinating facts can you find out to amaze your family, friends and teacher?

Find out about William the Conqueror. Search the web and use non-fiction books to find out all about him. Draw a picture and write 3 key facts that you have found out.

Spelling/Phonics

Every Friday you will receive spellings to be learnt for a test on the following Friday. These spellings will be in line with the spelling rule we will be learning each week.

Write a fictional story that is set in a castle. It could include Kings, Queens, Knights and Peasants.

Topic Task

Make a detailed diagram of a castle, labelling interesting features which might be found inside, or out. Perhaps you could find out about moats, drawbridges and turrets?

Maths Task

Complete the addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions in your book. Extra challenge - can you answer the missing numbers?

Teach A Skill

Teach someone at home how to do something (tie laces, draw an animal, play a game). Give detail and clear instructions, so they know exactly what to do.

Science Task

Complete the science activity sheet looking at the properties and uses of different materials (sheet provided)

Create a simple timeline for the Battle of Hastings. Start when Edward the Confessor dies and finish when William becomes the King.

Number Facts

Practice your multiplication and division facts for the 5 X tables (up to 12 X 5).
e.g. $3 \times 5 = 15$
 $5 \times 3 = 15$
 $15 \div 5 = 3$
 $15 \div 3 = 5$
