Let the school know about any concerns or circumstances that may affect my child's learning, behaviour, attendance or wellbeing.

Work in partnership with the school and attend meetings to discuss my child's progress and support their development.

Support the school's expectations for behaviour and encourage my child to follow its policies and routines.

Encourage and support my child with home learning, reading and other opportunities to practise their learning.

Read messages provided through the school website and MyEd to stay informed about policies, meetings, events and matters concerning my child.

Support the school's values and encourage my child to treat every member of the school community with kindness, inclusion and respect.

Communicate respectfully and constructively with staff, pupils and other members of the school community while respecting their privacy and confidentiality.

Help my child use the internet, mobile phones and other technology safely, responsibly and in accordance with age restrictions and school expectations
