Reading

Writing Task

Draw a Spring picture and label using the sounds that you have learnt – e.g flowers, lambs, chicks, sun.
Challenge – write a sentence about your picture
Complete by: 30.04.25

Challenge:

Think about how you have grown and changed from when you were a baby. Look back through old photos with a grown up and talk about how you have changed and what you have learnt to do.

Maths Task

Complete the counting to 20 worksheet.

Complete by: 07.05.25

Challenge:

Gather 10 items at home. Get an adults to hide some of the items – how many items are hidden?

Challenge:

Visit your local library and choose a reading for pleasure book that you love. Upload a photo to tapestry to show the book that you have chosen.

Challenge:

Plant a seed at home to see what it grows into. Maybe you could plant a sunflower or a tomato plant. Observe how the plant grows and changes.

Phonics

Please practice the spellings that are in your spelling book ready for the spelling tests we have every Monday.
Practice reading the high frequency words that are in your homework book.

Challenge:

Can you make a healthy snack that would make you grow big and strong. It could be a fruit salad or fruit kebab. Upload a photo of you enjoying your tasty treat on tapestry.

Challenge:

Complete a jigsaw with a grown up at home. Look at how you need to match the colours, patterns and rotate the shape to help you make your picture.

Understanding of the World Task:

Can you go on a flower hunt around your garden or a local area. Draw a picture of all of the flowers that you find.
Complete by: 14.05.25

Challenge:

What amazing facts can you find out about butterflies?

Topic Task:

Can you make a life cycle of an animal using craft resources or a drawing. It could be for a chick or a frog or a butterfly.

Complete by: 21.05.25

Challenge:

Get a grown up to hide high frequency words around the house or garden. How many can you find and read?
