Oak Class daily routines

Welcome to the final term of the academic year! Oak Class cannot wait to begin the 'On the Move' Topic.

General information:

Warmer weather- As the weather is warmer, please ensure your child has a named sun hat/cap in school. Please ensure you have applied sun cream before sending your child to school and that they have a named bottle of sun cream in school at all times. This will be kept in their tray and children will need to apply it themselves under adult supervision. It is also essential to have their water bottle in school every day with water only.

Reading- Please ensure that reading Journals are being used on a regular basis and that your child is continuing to learn to read the high frequency words.

Contact details- Please ensure your personal details, including work phone numbers & mobile phone numbers are up to date in the office. It is essential you keep us up to date with these, in case we need to contact you. Please see Mrs Warrington in the office if you need to change any details.

Reminders:

Attendance- Attendance is placed of high importance as a school and it is essential children are in school every day in order for them to make good progress. However, we appreciate illnesses cannot be helped. For more information on how much time to keep your child off school due to an illness, please refer to the schools website.

Healthy lunchboxes- If your child is having packed lunch at school please ensure it is a healthy lunchbox. As a school we promote healthy eating, therefore sweets are not permitted. For more information or advice on healthy lunchbox ideas, please visit the Change 4 Life website.

Uniform- A reminder that children should not be wearing nail varnish at school & if ears are pierced, a small plain stud should be worn. Smart black shoes should also be worn, unless your child has a medical need- and the class teacher knows about it.

PE days- PE lessons will continue to take place every Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon. Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school every week. A reminder that your child should not be wearing earrings on PE days.

Dinner menus- Please remember to select your child's lunch choices on the Parent Pay before midnight on Monday for the following week's dinners to be ordered. Any issues please speak to Mrs Warrington in the office. If you have not ordered a dinner for your child then please provide a packed lunch.

Homework- A reminder that homework is given on a Friday and is expected to be handed in completed on a Wednesday- the homework book and Spelling journal.
