**Important dates and information****Reading Books**

We strongly recommend that the children read a minimum of three times a week to support their progression. This must be recorded by an adult on 'Go Read'. This is an app/website that will be used instead of reading records. Your child can also record if they have read using 'Go Read' both school books and books they may have at home.

**Attendance**

The national average for attendance is 96%. This would equate to around 7 days off a year. If your child has a medical appointment, please make sure that you tell Mrs Warrington in the office and show her your appointment card. Any queries, please don't hesitate to ask the class teacher or Mrs Warrington.

**P.E. kits**

All children must bring a P.E. kit to school. P.E. this term will be on a Monday. We respectfully ask all parents and carers to check that their children have labels in their kit with their name on or that their name is written on the labels in fabric pen. If anyone has taken home the wrong kit by mistake, then please could they return it as soon as possible.

**Homework**

Homework will be set on a Friday and is due in every Wednesday. The homework is always explained to the children, however, if the children or parents have any questions, your class teacher will be happy to run through the work.

**Spelling Journal**

Spellings are set every Monday and will be stuck into your child's homework book. The children will be then tested on these spellings the following Monday. Children will be required to practise their spellings as part of their homework every week, in their homework books. Spelling journals will not be going home this term.

**Maple Class****Water Bottles**

Please ensure that it is water as squash and fizzy drinks are not permitted in the classroom.
